

Walkthrough for Brainstorm Dial-Up Account with Windows XP

This is a step-by-step walkthrough for configuring your computer to use your Brainstorm dial-up account. If you have any problems call us at our toll free number 1-877-651-6299. We are open Monday thru Friday from 8am- 10pm and Saturday thru Sunday from 9am- 6pm.

Windows XP Dial-Up:

1. Click on the green **Start button** on the bottom left hand corner.
2. Click on **Control Panel**

Windows XP has two views. There is classic view and there is category view. If you see "Pick a Category" in large letters then you are in category view, if you see a large list of small icons then you are in classic view. Switch to category view by clicking on "switch to category view" on the upper left hand corner of the window.

3. Click on **Network and Internet Connections**
4. Click on **Set up or change your internet connection**
5. Click on the **Setup** button on the upper-right hand corner.
6. A new window will open up and click on **Next** on the bottom-right hand corner
7. Make sure the green dot is in **Connect to the Internet**
8. Click **Next**
9. Make sure the green dot is in **Set up my connection manually**
10. Click **Next**
11. Make sure the green dot is in **Connect using a dial-up modem**
12. Click **Next**
13. Type in **Brainstorm** where it asks you for your ISP name.
14. Click on **Next**
15. Type in the correct dial-up number for a city that is local to you. Do not type in the area code. Here's a list of cities with their corresponding dial-up numbers:
 - Durango: 247-7798
 - Farmington: 716-4042
 - Grand Junction: 241-0044
 - Montrose: 240-2794
16. Click on **Next**
17. Type in your username (ex: **username@gobrainstorm.net**) at the end.
18. Enter your password in the **Password** and **Confirm Password** fields and all the checkboxes on the bottom can be left checked.
19. Click on **Next**
20. Check the **grey square** on the bottom. It will add a shortcut to Brainstorm on your desktop.
21. Click on **Finish** on the bottom.
22. **Close** the Network and Internet Connections window..
23. Double-click on the **Shortcut to Brainstorm** on your desktop.

24. Click on **Connect**
25. After it has connected open **Internet Explorer** to surf webpages or **Outlook Express** to check your email.
